Type of Claim: Auto accident. Plaintiff. in an SUV on Indiana Street at the juncture of 152 Highway in October, 2004 at 8:30 P.M. Defendant Robert Scott, an employee of Defendant Hunter Distribution, was driving his personal was the driver pick-up truck and made a left turn into the side of Plaintiff's vehicle causing the SUV to roll at least two times. Plaintiff: alleged Defendant Scott was intoxicated and fled the scene of the accident. He turned himself in the next day and admitted liability. Defendant Hunter Distribution maintained that Defendant Scott, although an employee, was on a private errand on his own time and was not liable, and that Defendant Scott fled the scene because of pre-existing anxiety and panic disorders.
